The 4th Scandinavian Physiological Society conference on Molecular Approaches to Membrane Transport will take place at the beautiful Sigtunastiftelsen (<http://www.sigtunastiftelsen.se>) in the vicinity of Stockholm from September 13th (from 15.00) to September 15th (to 13.00), 2012.

The conference will cover topics on several classes of membrane transport proteins, ranging from pumps, transporters, ion channels and gap junctional hemichannels.
